Role of Social Enterprise in Manitoba

- Aki Energy: First Nations Social Enterprise installs geo-thermal heating in first Nations Communities
- Building Urban Industry for Local
 Development (BUILD)/ Brandon Energy
 Efficiency Program (BEEP): RETROFITS
- Manitoba Green Retrofit (MGR):RETROFITS

Decent Jobs

- •BUILD/MGR employees earn between \$14 \$25 an hour
- Manitoba minimum wage: \$10.70
- Winnipeg living wage 2013: \$14.07

A combination of government initiatives

- Neighbourhood Renewal Corporations
 - Neighbourhoods Alive Tax Credit
- Manitoba Housing procurement policy
- New legislation to support social enterprise

The Energy Savings Act

- Key in allowing the three social enterprises to take advantage of the Power Smart program
- •Three elements:

Affordable Energy Fund

- Receives funds from MH exports
- Use of fund expanded to support social enterprises and community organizations

Energy Efficiency Plan

- Plan for increasing energy efficiency
- Includes targets and a strategy
- Must report annually

On-Meter Efficiency Improvement Program

•MH can finance the costs of home energy improvements through PAYS

PAYS and the Energy Fund Support of Social Enterprise

- Language that includes mandate to use social enterprises and
- **OPAYS**

Allow the social enterprises to operate

Raining on our parade: CETA

- Until ratified, BC could adopt Manitobalike measures
- After ratified, only Aboriginal set-asides will be allowed
- Manitoba excluded procurement of services and goods from Manitoba Hydro so it's not restricted to Aboriginal setasides.
